

Health Insurance

- **Medical, Dental & Prescription**: Offered through the State of New Mexico. Options include Presbyterian HMO and Blue Cross Blue Shield HMO/PPO.
- Vision: Voluntary coverage through VSP.

- Life Insurance: Basic and optional policies available through Dearborn National.
- **Disability & Supplemental Coverage**: Long-Term Disability, Critical Illness, Accident, and Hospital Indemnity coverage available.
- **Virtual Healthcare**: TimelyCare provides free 24/7 virtual health and mental wellness services to benefit-eligible employees.

#### **Eligibility**

Regular employees working at least 30 hours/week (.75 FTE) are eligible for benefits. Dependent coverage is available with required documentation.

## Premium Sharing

NMSU shares premiums for medical, life, and long-term disability insurance based on annual salary:

- <\$57,200: Employee 18% / NMSU 82%
- \$57,200–83,200: Employee 30% / NMSU 70%
- >\$83,200: Employee 40% / NMSU 60%

# **Tuition Benefits**

For You:

• Up to 6 credit hours per semester and 8 in summer—fully covered tuition and required fees.

#### For Your Family:

- Spouse/Domestic Partner: Eligible to use unused employee credits.
- Children: 50% discount on in-state tuition for qualified dependents under 25.

## Leave & Time Off

- Annual Leave: Up to 21 days per year for eligible employees
- Sick Leave: Up to 12 days per year (eligibility varies by employee classification)
- Observed Holidays: 14 holidays including Winter Break, Spring Holiday, and more
- FMLA, Sick Leave Bank, Faculty Care Leave: Additional leave protections available

## **Retirement Options**

NMSU offers:

- New Mexico Educational Retirement Board (ERB): Defined benefit plan for eligible employees (see <a href="MERB Member Handbook">MMERB Member Handbook</a>)
- Alternative Retirement Plan (ARP): Defined contribution plan for eligible faculty, coaches, and executive staff

• Voluntary Retirement: 403(b), 457(b), and Roth plans available

#### Additional Perks

- TimelyCare & EAP: Virtual healthcare and confidential counseling support
- **Professional Development**: University training offered through the Center for Learning & Professional Development
- **LinkedIn Learning**: Free access to thousands of online courses for faculty and staff to enhance personal and professional skills
- AggieFit Access: Low-cost membership for fitness centers and classes
- **Discount Programs**: Reduced rates on events, merchandise, and services
